

**PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004
PART 1 SECTION 2
DIRECTION RECOGNISING A BODY AS A REGIONAL
PLANNING BODY**

Pursuant to Part 1 Section 2(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the Secretary of State directs that the South West Strategic Leaders' Board (the executive arm of South West Councils), as augmented in the attachment to this Direction, is recognised as the Regional Planning Body for the South West region on and from 8 May 2009.

Pursuant to Part 1 Section 2(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the Secretary of State directs that recognition of the South West Regional Assembly as Regional Planning Body is withdrawn with effect on and from 8 May 2009.
